How can I make sure my loved ones are protected?

Can I leave my super to friends, nondependent family members or charity?

Yes. But only by nominating your legal personal representative on this form so that your super is paid in accordance with your will. You should make sure your will is kept up to date. Non-dependent beneficiary payments may also be subject to tax.

What happens if I don't nominate anyone?

If you die without nominating chosen recipients, Qantas Super will distribute your money to a dependant or legal personal representative. Dependants are given priority and we will usually transfer funds to your estate if there is no other option.

Can I change a nomination?

You can renew, cancel or make a new nomination at any time by filling out and submitting a new nomination. We recommend updating your nomination if your circumstances change, for example, marriage, divorce or children.

Who do I tell about my nominations?

It's a good idea to make sure your beneficiaries know your super fund account details to make the claim process easier.

Do I need to update my binding nomination?

Binding nominations need to be updated every three years. We will remind you before the expiry of your nomination.
